FOCUS association based in Vevey invites INSIDE OUT group from Kyrgyzstan to discover the helvetic artistic scene from September, 5 to 25. Eight Swiss artists – **Adrienne et Camille Scherrer, Yann Gross, Régis Tosetti, Simon Deppierraz, Simon Palmieri, David Favrod et Federico Berardi** will work with four Kyrgyz artists - **Bermet Borubaeva, Nikolai Cherkasov, Anatoly Kolesnikov et Dmitri Petrovskii** – during two weeks and will present the innovative exhibition TET A TET #2 at former supermarket EX-EPA in Vevey.

Their adventure started in October 2009 during the second part of exchange in Kyrgyzstan. They learned from this experience the possibility of an extraordinary artistic synergy, combining contemporary art and cultural diversity. Mountain as a base for working has generated a dynamic and innovative, 8'000 kilometers far from Bern. They are now back in Switzerland to develop a fascinating TET A TET #2 !
